### **News From the Pews & Other Ministries**

★ The 2025 Minimum Salaries and Reimbursements for Ministry Personnel document is now available online. You can find it in the Downloads section at the bottom of the Ministers' Salary Schedule and Cost of Living Groups webpage. The increases to salaries of ministry personnel are not automatically made by ADP. General Council Office staff do not update ADP with minimum salary

data. Your pastoral charge ADP administrator must update the minister's salary in TeamPay or inform ADP of the new salary amount for the pay period beginning January 1.

#### ★ Calling All Youth! Youth Forum 2025 Applications

Youth Forum is open to young people, ages 15 to 25, selected by regional councils. Youth Forum leaders have the ambitious and achievable goal of having 100 young people under age 30 attend General Council 45. Each region is asked to select up to six youth, with a minimum of 50% of participants being Racialized and/or Indigenous young people. Leaders across the world and particularly in Canada are failing to take the decisive action needed to protect our world, and particularly the most vulnerable members of the global community. For the Love of Creation invites groups across Canada to host candlelight vigils in their own communities on the weekend of November 15-17, 2024.
