### ★ Federal election campaign, now through April 27

Resources are coming from the national church as this important moment for discerning our collective response to pressing social issues begins. Here are some principles recently discussed at a shared national and regional meeting:

- \* As the church, we don't choose one party; we address all of them, and expect accountability of all of them.
- \* Speak up for what you believe in, not only what you oppose.
- \* Name your values, including what your faith calls you to. Try to ask others, especially those you disagree with, to name their values. Respond rather than react, working with communal and individual spiritual and faith resources.
- \* Encourage people to engage the whole process, and vote.
- \* Watch out for dis/misinformation. We are all vulnerable to it, because it's tailored to spark an emotional reaction and to reinforce what we already believe. Always check your sources and think before you post or share. Ask others for their sources where needed.
