Lent: The Perfect Time to Strengthen Invitation

Ok, so maybe Lent isn't the *best* season to invite new people to church, but it is the perfect time to start planning how your community of faith is going to strengthen your invitation for Easter. Lent is the season when we prepare our hearts and minds – and our churches – to receive and proclaim the good news of resurrection and God's promise of healing for a hurting world.

In the Easter story, those who bear witness to Christ's resurrection are sent to share this good news with others and invite them to encounter the risen Christ for themselves. That call still resonates for us, today. Yet, as my colleague, Scott Reynolds wrote in his recent worship blog: Our church matters to us deeply, but we sometimes have a hard time naming how God has been present in our lives through the ministry of our church. That's especially true when we're in conversation with our friends and neighbours who don't already attend.
