


# News from the Region: April 16, 2025



#### **Short reminders of our history for this Centennial year**

Throughout 2025, we'll be featuring very short stories about United Church history. Thanks to historian Gayle Simonson in Edmonton, we can also offer 100-word history vignettes for use in your own community! Here are vignettes 1-8. And brand new, here are vignettes 9-17. (Word format; when you click, the file will save automatically to your Downloads folder.) For our next vignette, she writes:

Before Union, each denomination had its own printing business to produce news and resources. Ryerson Press, the Methodist church publishing business, boasted 'the most completely equipped printing and binding plant in Canada." Its *Christian Guardian* dated to 1829, *The Presbyterian Witness* to 1848, and *The Congregationalist* to 1854. At union they combined to form *The New Outlook.* In 1938, merged with two other United Church publications, it was renamed the *United Church Observer.* That name was recently changed to *Broadview.* It remains the oldest continuously published magazine in North America and the second oldest in the English-speaking world.

The Global South and Indigenous communities face a devastating debt crisis, with many nations spending more on debt repayments than on healthcare, education or climate action. - \* **Debt cancellation** for unjust and unsustainable debts.
- \* Global financial reform to prevent future crises.
- \* A debt resolution framework within the United Nations that is transparent, binding and fair.
